AWARDS - HIGHLAND & NATIONALS COMPETITIONS

Age classes for all categories in both competitions will be determined once entries have closed

PRE-PREMIER: Medals will be awarded to six places in both Highland & Nationals competitions.

BEGINNER/NOVICE/INTERMEDIATE: Winner & First runner-up trophies.

TROPHY FLING: Trophy to Winner and medals to 3 places.

PREMIER:

HIGHLAND: Cash prizes to six places will be awarded to ALL Premier classes

Senior Premier Class: \$100/\$75/\$50/\$40/\$30/\$20; prize money will scale down depending on the number of age classes

NATIONALS: Cash prizes will be award to the two Senior Premier classes. Senior Class - \$100/\$75/\$50/\$40/\$30/\$20; Class 2 - \$50/\$40/\$30/\$20/\$15/\$10.

All other Premier classes in the Nationals competition will be awarded medals to six places.

PREMIER:

<u>Dancer of the Games Trophy</u>: High aggregate over the *three* days of competition, including Championship. Age classes must have a minimum of six dancers competing. Each dance must have a minimum of six dancers competing.

<u>Shirley Ashdown</u> <u>Memorial Trophy</u>: **Seann Triubhas -** Dance off for Winners of the Premier Seann Triubhas on Sunday.

Fergus Festival Scholarship - Trophy & Cash Prize of \$250: Premier 14 years dancer with the highest aggregate over the games including the Championship (Six dancer minimum in age class and in each dance)

<u>One Airline Ticket to Scotland</u>: (Maximum value of \$1,000). Premier Trophy Winners & Runners-Up in the Sunday Highland competition will be included in the draw for one airline ticket to Scotland.

FERGUS SCOTTISH FESTIVAL & HIGHLAND GAMES COMPETITION & CHAMPIONSHIP RULES -- PLEASE READ CAREFULLY

- > The Championships & Competitions will be governed by the rules of the RSOBHD, SDC & HDAO.
- In order to compete, dancers must be registered with the RSOBHD or RSOBHD subsidiary body (such as ScotDance Canada). All competitors must present their current RSOBHD registration card at the registration table on the day of competition for every competition. Any dancer unable to show a valid registration card will pay a \$10.00 fee to the organizer and will forfeit all awards until such time as the card is produced. If the card is not produced within 10 days, their name will be passed on to all Organizers who will be advised not to accept entries from the dancer or allow them to compete until such matters are satisfactorily resolved. Costs incurred for mailing awards will be payable to the Competition Organizer.
- > Age groups will be decided at the discretion of the HDAO & Fergus Dance Committee
- > Dancers must dance in own category and age group. Dancers will dance in inverse order of entry and must dance in numerical sequence or be disqualified
- 2025 Championship steps must be danced for the Championships
- > Judge's decision is final. No discussion can be entered into between a judge and a competitor or the parent or legal guardian of a competitor. Any complaint must be in writing with the complainant's signature, accompanied by \$35.00 and given to the Fergus Dance Committee (prior to the end of the day). The fee will be forfeited if the complaint is not upheld.
- > **IMPORTANT:** No status/category changes on the day of the competition. Email status changes to the Registrar at **dancefergus@gmail.com**. Last day for change is **Monday, August 4, 2025.**
- No refunds of entry fees or advance sale admission tickets.
- > This is a three-day competition Keep your number for Friday/Saturday/Sunday.
- Dancers are asked to participate in the Massed Fling during Opening Ceremonies on Saturday. Dancers asked to participate in the Honour Guard will be notified in advance of the Games.
- > Saturday Pre-Premier awards will be presented after the Opening Ceremonies on Saturday.
- > Championship awards will be presented following completion of the Championships.
- Nationals Competition Awards will be presented following the Nationals Competition.
- > Highland Premier Awards & Special Awards will be presented following the Highland Competition.
- > Tents without sides may be erected in the designated areas only.
- Entries must be completed by the dancer's parent/legal guardian or by the dancer (if 18 years or older). Only the parent/legal guardian or dancer (if 18 years or older) may complete acknowledgement of the waivers. Entries made by someone other than the parent/legal guardian or dancer will not be accepted.

COVID-19 PROTOCOLS

This event is being held in compliance with all provincial health and safety orders, as well as facility requirements for Covid-19.
